RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ABSENTEE BALLOT BOARD
FOR MARCH 2026 TOWNSHIP ELECTION

WHEREAS, Lynden Township is required by Minnesota Statute 203B.121 to establish a Ballot Board to examine and "accept" or "reject" the absentee ballot return envelopes; and

WHEREAS, this board will bring uniformity in the processing of accepting or rejecting returned absentee ballots in Lynden Township; and

WHEREAS, the Ballot Board would consist of a sufficient number of election judges as provided in sections 203B.23 and 204B.19 to 204B.22 trained in the processing and counting of absentee ballots;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Town Board for the Town of Lynden hereby establishes a Ballot Board that would consist of the following members:
